Woollam Constructions 125 and proud to keep special culture alive

WITH a history that spans nearly 125 years in Queensland, Woollam Constructions is a leader in the commercial and industrial construction industry.

Woollam Constructions, originally known as TF Woollam and Sons, rebranded in 2006 to reflect the organisation's evolution and the input of a younger face in senior management.

But business development manager Scott Wedgwood said the core of the company had not been forgotten.

"Having an office in Rockhampton in such a central location allows us to not only service the whole of Rockhampton, but many of the surrounding regional areas.
